Frequent Asked Questions

What if I sign my kid up for the wrong program?

That's no problem! Our coaches will make adjustments once we see the children on the ice.

Is it too soon for my 3 year old to learn how to skate?

Absolutely not, but please be aware, some children will be more comfortable than others.

When can my child be put on an actual hockey team?

If the child is confident and comfortable in Learn to Play, they can be put on a team before December 31.
