An in-person driver education 30-hour classroom program for Fairmont area students will begin in October for students 14 and half years old and older. Class approved by State of Minnesota. The class will be held on the following dates: October 19-October 23 and October 26-October 30. Make up day: November 2. (NO WEEKENDS). Class held at the Fairmont Opera House, lower level. The class will be from 6:00-9:00 p.m. to accommodate the schedule of those students in athletics or fine arts. There will be a parent meeting on Monday, October 19 from 5:00-6:30 p.m. ALL STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE AT CLASS FROM 6:00-9:00 P.M. ON OCTOBER 19. If parent attends meeting, students will only be required to drive with parents 40 hours instead of 50. A Certificate of Attendance will be distributed to those parents that attend the parent meeting. A minimum of 15 students is needed to provide a class with maximum of 30. If there are not enough registrations, parents will be contacted about cancellation of the class after the October 21 deadline. If you do not hear from me, the class is a go! Students should bring a pen or pencil, highlighter, mask, notebook paper, and folder to class. STATE SAFETY PROTOCOLS WILL BE FOLLOWED: SOCIAL DISTANCING-MASKS WORN-TABLE & CHAIRS SANITIZED DAILY.

SUMMARY OF THE DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM

- *Students age 15 and older successfully completing the classroom program can take their state written exam at the examining station in Mankato.
- *Behind-the-wheel training (6 hours of driving time) is done throughout the school year. The instructor will contact the student/parent to schedule driving time.
- *Instruction is typically taught weekdays between the hours of 3:30-5:00 p.m. during the school year and 8:00-1:00 during the summer. Winter driving available.
- *Parents are required to ride with student for 40 or 50 hours above and beyond the six hours with instructor. A log sheet of driving experience is required by state.
- *The student is driving alone with the instructor for one-on-one driving instruction.
- *By law, students must wait six months after receiving their permit to qualify for a driver's license even if the student is sixteen years old. If behind the wheel openings are available, students that turn sixteen or older within that six-month waiting period, will be completed first as well as those that qualify for a farm permit. Students should let Mr. Uttech know during one of the class days that he/she qualifies for their license early.
- *Total cost of the driver education program for the classroom phase and behind-the-wheel training is \$300.00, a price that has not increased in years! Payment Plan Available Upon Request. Students must have \$200.00 paid by the end of the classroom phase on October 30. Thanks for selecting our program!!
- *Parents and students should be aware that the hours of classroom and behind-the-wheel-training are the minimum requirements set by law. If a student lacks any of the required time, he/she must make up the time and will be assessed an additional fee of \$30.00.
- *If a student is unable to complete the classroom and/or behind the wheel program a refund will be available. If the student had already started the class and/or behind the wheel instruction and decides to leave, the money refunded will be prorated accordingly. If a student wishes to take the classroom program only, the cost is \$125.00 and the cost for behind the wheel only is \$30.00/hour.
- *This agreement constitutes a contract between GHEC/RM Driving and the student/parent and no verbal statements or promises will be recognized.
- *Before taking the state written exam, your student must have an original certified birth certificate and social security card. If your child was born in another state and plans to take his/her written driving exam immediately after completing the classroom program, you should contact the county courthouse as soon as possible in the state/county the child was born to obtain a certified birth certificate.
